

## Successfully launched "Safety Upgrade Subsidy Program"

The MOP 30 million "Safety Upgrade Subsidy Program for Communal Electrical Installations in Low-rise Aging Buildings" established by CEM shareholders was launched in March. We aim to subsidize the upgrade of communal electrical installations in aging buildings over 30 years old and less than seven storeys. The first two upgrading cases are at Edf. Fai On at Rua do Rebanho and Edf. Sun Po at Rua de Fernão Mendes Pinto.

CEM will leverage its professional knowledge to conduct assessment and screen eligible buildings for the subsidy with fairness and impartiality. The upgrade will be carried out by contractors commissioned by CEM. CEM will be responsible for technical supervision. It is estimated that 150 to 200 buildings can be subsidized in three years. Citizens can visit CEM website to check if their building is included in the "List of Eligible Buildings", which is updated constantly.





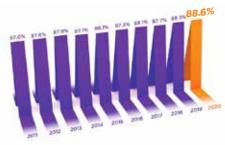




## Cultivating the younger generation
